Stormwater Management

In 2023, the Ross County Board of Commissioners approved Stormwater Management and Sediment Control Regulations for Ross County. The regulations apply to commercial and industrial development including major subdivisions. This does not include normal agricultural practices or buildings. The regulations were established to effectively manage stormwater and minimize erosion from development. Ross County has designated the administration and enforcement of these regulations to the Ross Soil and Water Conservation District. A permit is required for all development equal to one-half acre or greater. Permits and a copy of the complete regulations are available online at www.rosscountyswcd.org.

Tree Sale 2024

Ross SWCD is now accepting orders for the annual tree sale. Orders are **due February 14th**. The annual tree sale is a long-standing conservation project intended to get tree seedlings planted to prevent soil erosion and provide for a more healthy environment. Tree pickup day is scheduled for March 22nd.

Sales Tax Notification

Soil and Water districts across the state are now required to collect sales tax. Some purchases will stay tax exempt for producers who can claim a farming exemption. However, the district is required to collect sales tax on tree and fish sales. The tax rate in Ross County is 7.25%. Please multiply your order amount by .0725 and then add amount to the total.
